ORDINANCE NO. 1057

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 15 "RATES AND CHARGES". OF ORDINANCE NO. 995 AND PROVIDING THAT MONTHLY CHARGES FOR BOTH RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL CABLE TELEVISION SERVICE SHALL BE ESTABLISHED BY THE CABLE OPERATOR ("PERMITTEE"); PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The City Council of the City of Roswell having conducted a public hearing in regard to the changes effected herein and having determined that the changes are necessary and in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Roswell,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO THAT:

1. The portion of Section 15, "Rates and Charges", Ordinance No. 995 relating to residential rates for cable television service is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 15. Rates and Charges. Rates and charges for residential and commercial cable television service shall be as the Permittee may from time to time determine to be justifiable in the Permittee's judgment. The City of Roswell reserves the right to impose rate restrictions, as may be permitted by law, in the event of any assignment or transfer or permittee's rights under this ordinance.

- 2. REPEALER. All ordinances, parts of ordinances or sections of the Municipal Code in conflict or inconsistent herewith be, and the same hereby are repealed to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency. This repealer is not to be construed as reviving any ordinances, parts of ordinances or sections of the Municipal Code heretofore repealed.
- 3. SEVERABILITY. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance should for any reason be held invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.
- 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be and become effective five days after its publication.
