

ORDINANCE NO. 1083

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL AMENDING SECTION 32-22 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL; PROVIDING FOR INCREASE OF THE CITY'S OCCUPANCY TAX TO THREE PERCENT; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, THAT:

Section 1. The occupancy tax imposed in Section 32-22 of the code of the City of Roswell is hereby increased from two percent of gross taxable revenues to three percent of gross taxable revenues. Said is hereby levied upon such revenues as of the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 2. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part of any ordinance heretofore repealed.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance for any reason shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.


Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be and become effective on or after five days following publication of this ordinance.
