

ORDINANCE NO. 1093

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1077 PROVIDING FOR A NEW AND INCREASED RATE SCHEDULE FOR CONNECTION TO THE SEWER SYSTEM; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Roswell, New Mexico, desires to provide for increases in the amounts charged for tapping into the sewer system,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

Section 1: That Section 3 of Ordinance 1077 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 3 - Sewer Tap Fee" The following tap fee schedule is established based on the size of the water meter.

3/4" tap fee -----	\$250.00
1" tap fee -----	\$350.00
1½" tap fee -----	\$500.00
2" tap fee -----	\$625.00
3" or larger, tap fee -----	100% of installed water meter price.

No tap fee will be charged for separate fire line.


Section 2: Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part of any ordinance heretofore repealed.

Section 3: Severability: If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance for any reason shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity of unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.


Section 4: Effective Date. This ordinance shall be and become effective on and after July 11, 1983.

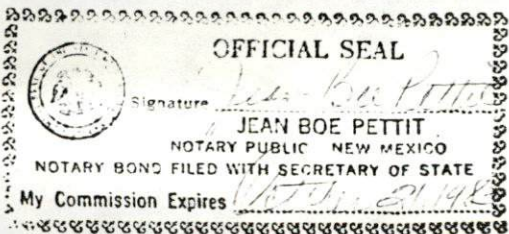
