

ORDINANCE NO. 1112

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE FINAL ASSESSMENT PLAT FOR BRASHER ROAD PAVING DISTRICT NO. 1982-1, FROM MAIN STREET WEST TO SUNSET AVENUE AND ORDERING THAT THE ASSESSMENTS BE LEVIED AGAINST THE ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, that:

1. The City Council, after a Public Hearing on Brasher Road Paving District No. 1982-1 and after considering all public input and comments, hereby approves and ratifies the Final Assessment Roll and further orders that the assessments against abutting property owners contained in Attachment A are hereby adopted.


2. The assessment against each abutting property owner is due and payable by February 17, 1984. After that date any assessment not paid in full will be subject to a maximum three (3) year deferred payment plan at an interest rate of six percent (6%) per annum with interest commencing on February 17, 1984. Payment shall be in semi-annual installments with the first payment plus interest due on August 17, 1984.

3. Any assessment not paid or delinquent for any six (6) month period including interest shall constitute a lien against the property.


4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part of any ordinance heretofore repealed.
