

ORDINANCE NO. 1121

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL ADOPTING A NEW AND REVISED MASTER PLAN FOR THE CITY, PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the firm of BRW, Inc. has prepared a new master plan for the City of Roswell, and

WHEREAS, the proposed new master plan has been reviewed and recommended by the City staff and the City Planning and Zoning Commission, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City that the plan, dated February 14, 1984, be adopted,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that:

Section 1. The master plan prepared by BRW, Inc. and dated February 14, 1984 is hereby adopted as the official master plan of the City.

Section 2. The master plan as adopted herein shall include the accompanying maps, plats, charts, descriptive and explanatory matter.


Section 3. The master plan documents shall be available for inspection at the City's planning department and may be purchased through the City Clerk's office at cost.

Section 4. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part of any ordinance heretofore repealed.

Section 5. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance for any reason shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.


Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be and become effective on or after five days following publication of this ordinance.
