

ORDINANCE NO. 1169

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL AMENDING SECTION 29-3 OF THE ROSWELL CITY CODE; PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN THE PENALTY ASSESSMENT FEE COLLECTED FROM PERSONS VIOLATING ANY ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE OPERATION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE; DETERMINING EXPENDITURES OF SAID PENALTY ASSESSMENT FEES; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that:

Section 1. Section 29-3 of the Roswell City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 29-3. Additional penalty assessment fees for violations. Any person violating any ordinance relating to the operation of a motor vehicle for which a penalty assessment schedule has been established, and who chooses to pay the penalty assessment shall pay in addition to the penalty assessment, a penalty assessment fee of ten dollars (\$10.00). All penalty assessment fees, collected above and beyond the penalty assessment, shall be deposited in a special fund in the municipal treasury and shall be used solely for municipal jailer training, the construction planning, construction, operation and maintenance of a municipal jail, for paying the cost of housing municipal prisoners in other detention facilities in the state or complying with match or contribution requirements for the receipt of federal funds relating to jails.

Section 2. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or fee schedules in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part of any ordinance heretofore repealed.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance for any reason shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.


Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect on August 1, 1987.
