

ORDINANCE NO. 1171

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL AMENDING SECTION 29-4 OF THE ROSWELL CITY CODE; PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN THE CORRECTIONS FEE COLLECTED FROM PERSONS CONVICTED OF VIOLATING ANY ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE OPERATION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE; DETERMINING EXPENDITURES OF SAID CORRECTIONS FEE; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HERewith; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, THAT:

Section 1. Section 29-4 of the Roswell City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 29-4. Special court costs for violations. Any person convicted of violating any ordinance relating to the operation of a motor vehicle shall pay a ten dollar (\$10.00) corrections fee to the municipal judge who shall collect such fees as court costs. All corrections fees collected pursuant to this section shall be deposited in a special fund in the municipal treasury and shall be used solely for municipal jailer training, the construction planning, construction, operation and maintenance of a municipal jail, for paying the cost of housing municipal prisoners in a county jail or complying with match or contribution requirements for the receipt of federal funds relating to jails.

Section 2. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or fee schedules in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part of any ordinance heretofore repealed.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance for any reason shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.


Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect on July 1, 1987.
