

ORDINANCE NO. 1172

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL AMENDING SECTIONS OF ARTICLE IV IN CHAPTER 14 OF THE ROSWELL CITY CODE; PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN THE OCCUPANCY TAX RATE; PROVIDING FOR THE CONFIDENTIALITY OF REPORTS REQUIRED OF INDIVIDUAL VENDORS; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES OR PORTIONS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, THAT:

Section 1. Section 14-68 of the Roswell City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 14-68. Levied; amount. There is hereby levied an occupancy tax of five (5) percent of gross taxable revenues accrued by reason of rent paid for lodging to vendors.

Section 2. Section 14-71 of the Roswell City Code is hereby amended by addition of the following subsection:

(e) The reports of individual vendors required by subsection (d) are confidential and not subject to public inspection.


Section 3. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or fee schedules in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part of any ordinance heretofore repealed.

Section 4. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance for any reason shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.


Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect on July 1, 1987.
