

## ORDINANCE NO. 1279

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL AMENDING SECTION 3-5 OF THE ROSWELL CITY CODE RELATING TO SPECIAL DISPENSERS PERMITS, MAKING THE CITY PERMIT MANDATORY AND INCREASING THE FEE FOR ISSUANCE OF THE PERMIT, PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that:

**Section 1.** Roswell City Code Section 3-5 is amended to read as follows:

Any person holding a dispenser's license for the sale of alcoholic liquors within the City and a special permit required by Section 60-6A-12 of the New Mexico Statutes Annotated, 1978, shall obtain a special permit for the sale of alcoholic liquors at such occasion upon the payment in advance of the sum of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per day of such event. The application for such license and the issuance thereof shall be as provided for in this article. The holder of any such special permit shall be subject to all provisions of all ordinances of the City governing the sale of alcoholic liquors.

**Section 2.** Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such conflict or inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part of any ordinance heretofore repealed.

**Section 3.** Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance for any reason shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.

**Section 4.** Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective five days following its publication.
