ORDINANCE NO. 1280

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL AMENDING SECTION 1-8(b) OF THE ROSWELL CITY CODE RELATING TO MANDATORY FEES COLLECTED UPON CONVICTION, ADDING A TRAFFIC SAFETY FEE AND INCREASING THE COURT AUTOMATION FEE, PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that:

Section 1. Roswell City Code Section 1-8(b) is amended to read as follows:

- (b) Mandatory fee collected upon conviction. In addition to any fine or imprisonment described in subsection (a) of this section, there is imposed upon any person convicted of violating any municipal ordinance the penalty for which carries a potential jail term, or nay ordinance relating to the operation of a motor vehicle, the following mandatory fees:
 - (1) A corrections fee of ten dollars (\$10.00)
 - (2) A judicial-education fee of one dollar (\$1.00)
 - (3) A court automation fee of ten dollars (\$10.00)
 - (4) A traffic-safety fee of three dollars (\$3.00)
- Section 2. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such conflict or inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any ordinance or part of any ordinance heretofore repealed.
- Section 3. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance for any reason shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.
- Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective five days following its publication.
