

ORDINANCE NO. 1308

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL AMENDING SECTION 18-2 OF THE ROSWELL CITY CODE TO PROVIDE FOR COMPENSATION FOR THE MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AND FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body, the City Council, of Roswell, New Mexico desires to change Section 18-2 of the Roswell City Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that:

Section 1. In the Roswell City Code (1984), Section 18-2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Compensation for the office of municipal judge is hereby fixed monthly as follows:

Up to (2) Years Service as Roswell Municipal Judge	\$3,190.00
Upon Second Anniversary as Roswell Municipal Judge	\$3,349.50
Upon Fourth Anniversary as Roswell Municipal Judge	\$3,509.00

Said compensation at the above rates shall be payable to the duly elected municipal judge or his successors incumbent in office according to law in such case made and provided. In addition to the above amounts, the municipal judge shall receive benefits provided by the City to other employees including, but not limited to, the employer's share of social security and public employees retirement contributions.


Section 2. Repealer. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent only of such conflict or inconsistency. This repealer shall not be construed to revive any Ordinance or part of any Ordinance heretofore repealed.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance for any reason shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.


Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective five days following its publication.
