WHEREAS, the privately owned public transportation facilities in
operation within the City of Roswell are inadequate, and

WHEREAS, it is not possible for existing franchise operators to render
necessary service with adequate resulting return on the investment of capital
within this municipality, and

WHEREAS, assignment of the existing franchise by the holder or release
thereof and granting of a new franchise by the City of Roswell will not
afford adequate service,

NOW, THEREFORE be it resolved by the governing body, the City
Council of Roswell, New Mexico:

That the City of Roswell elects to engage in the business of transportation of
passengers and property within the municipality by whatever means it may
decide, and may do all things necessary for the acquisition and conduct of
the business of transportation as authorized within the Municipal Transit
Law, Chapters 3-52-1 to 3-52-13, NMSA 1978.



NOW, THEREFORE be it resolved by the governing body, the City Council of Roswell, New Mexico:


