

**RESOLUTION NO. 01-15**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A STREET NAME CHANGE FOR ONE BLOCK OF EAST CHISUM STREET, FROM CHISUM STREET TO ST. MARY'S PLACE AND AUTHORIZING A VARIANCE TO ROSWELL CITY CODE 19-27. SCHEME (street numbering) TO ALLOW THE USE OF THE DESIGNATION OF "1" AN ODD NUMBER, ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE STREET:

**WHEREAS**, the City of Roswell wishes to approve the street name change, and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Chaves, owner of a portion of the properties affected by this change, has requested that the section of Chisum Street lying between South Main Street and Southeast Main Street be changed to St. Mary's Place, and

**WHEREAS**, currently the area wherein the street affected by this change is City owned property, and

**WHEREAS**, Mr. S. P. Johnson, owner of a portion of the properties affected by this change, has agreed to the name change, and

**WHEREAS**, the requested street name change does not duplicate a street name in other approved subdivisions and


**WHEREAS**, County of Chaves, owner of the property affected by this change has requested a variance to Roswell City Code Section 19-27. Scheme (street numbering), to allow the use of the designation of "1" an odd number, on the south side of the street (Code requires the south side of a street to be numbered with even numbers).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AND DECLARED** by the governing body, the City Council of Roswell, New Mexico, that the one block of East Chisum Street lying between South Main Street and Southeast Main Street be changed to St. Mary's Place and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND DECLARED** by the governing body, the City Council of Roswell, New Mexico, that the Chaves County Administrative Center on the south side of St. Mary's Place be known as 1 St. Mary's Place.


