

**RESOLUTION NO. 05-06**

A CONTRACT FUNDING RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO  
NOTIFYING THE NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT THAT  
THE CITY OF ROSWELL SUPPORTS THE MUNICIPAL ARTERIAL PROGRAM APPLICATION  
FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF EAST FIFTH STREET FROM  
N. MAIN STREET (US 285) TO N. ATKINSON AVENUE

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to mill and inlay East Fifth from N. Main Street to  
N. Atkinson Avenue, and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell has agreed to provide matching funds at a percentage rate  
of 25% of the cost of construction, and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell has agreed to fund all project development, environmental  
analysis, and the design costs separate from the cost of construction, and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell has agreed to fund all on-going maintenance costs for this  
project after construction, and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell supports this project and desires to receive funding, and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell understands two resolutions must be submitted, one at the  
time of project application and another at the time the project is formally under contract with the New  
Mexico Department of Transportation, and

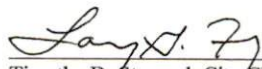
WHEREAS, this resolution is an application for Municipal Arterial Project funding, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND DECLARED by the Governing Body, the  
City Council of the City of Roswell, New Mexico that Mayor Bill B. Owen, be and hereby is,  
authorized to submit an application for Municipal Arterial Program funding with the New Mexico  
Department of Transportation for the mill and inlay of East Fifth Street in Roswell, New Mexico and  
hereby commits to the funding of such project as specified in the project application.
