

**RESOLUTION NO. 15-61**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO DIRECTING STAFF TO PROCEED WITH THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL PROCESS FOR THE SITE SELECTION, DESIGN AND ENGINEERING OF A NEW RECREATION FACILITY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Roswell Yucca Recreation Center located at 500 South Richardson Avenue was constructed in 1911 and renovated in 1940 and 1972 for use by the citizens of this community; and

**WHEREAS**, due its extended age and use the Yucca Recreation Center continues to deteriorate and lacks the functionality to meet the City's recreational needs into the future; and

**WHEREAS**, the need to address the City's recreation center was identified in the 2007 Parks, Recreation and Open Space Master Plan Update; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 13, 2014 the City Council adopted Resolution 14-52 supporting the building of a recreation center for the benefit of the citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council conducted a workshop on August 27, 2015 during which general direction was provided to staff as it relates to proceeding with the process to construct a new recreation facility; and

**WHEREAS**, staff has developed the necessary documents and is prepared, based on Council approval, to proceed with Requests for Proposals (RFP) for site selection, design and engineering of a new recreation facility.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO** hereby directs staff to proceed with the request for proposal process for the site selection, design and engineering of a new recreation facility for the citizens of Roswell.
