

RESOLUTION NO.17-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A NEW MEXICO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION / LOCAL GOVERNMENT DIVISION; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACT AS THE CITY OF ROSWELL'S CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY OF ROSWELL'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the need exists within the City of Roswell for neighborhood improvement projects in several low and moderate income neighborhoods, and that the City of Roswell desires to apply to the Housing and Urban Development's Community Development Block Grant Program to obtain funding for neighborhood improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has held three public hearings 7/6/2016 at 5 pm; 7/7/2016 at 5 pm; 8/11/2016 at 6 pm for public input and comment on and during the 2017 application process; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that there is a significant need to undertake the to provide adequate services to the community; and

WHEREAS, the City Council determines that the Sidewalk & ADA Improvements on North Garden Avenue from 19th Street to Country Club Road meets the requirements of the Community Development Block Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that

1. The City of Roswell is hereby authorized to prepare and submit a Community Development Block Grant application to the New Mexico Department of Finance and Administration/Local Government Division for the Side walk & ADA Improvements on North Garden Avenue from 19th Street to Country Club Road;
2. That the City Council directs and designates the Mayor as the City of Roswell's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters about this application and the City of Roswell's participation in the New Mexico Community Development Block Grant Program;
3. The City of Roswell's officials and staff are directed to do all acts necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution;
4. That the full application estimated amount be for \$639,285 of grant funds and Phased be for \$319,645 for the partial project of North Garden Avenue Sidewalk Project;

5. That it further be stated that the City of Roswell is committing an estimated \$63,928 of local funding from its General Fund as a cash contribution toward the construction activities of this Sidewalk & ADA Improvements on North Garden Avenue from 19th Street to Country Club Road.


