A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADOPT PERSONNEL POLICIES ALLOWING FOR CITY EMPLOYEES TO CARRY CONCEALED WEAPONS ON CITY PROPERTY


Whereas, prominent local and national tragedies have highlighted the need for individuals to be able to provide for their own safety and the safety of those around them; and

Whereas, allowing persons who are duly permitted to carry a concealed weapon in the State of New Mexico to carry a concealed weapon on City property provides this needed measure of protection; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council as the GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NM, that:

1. The City Manager is to make provisions in City policy to allow employees who possess a New Mexico Concealed Carry Permit to carry a concealed weapon on City property subject to the conditions of the Permit and subject to notice to the City Manager and an employee's Department Head-level Supervisor.
2. The City Manager is further directed to take any additional appropriate action to enact the intent and purpose of this Resolution.
