

RESOLUTION 19-04

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CITY COUNCIL INTENT
TO USE URBAN DEVELOPMENT GRANT FUNDS AT THE
ROSWELL INTERNATIONAL AIR CENTER**

WHEREAS, in 1977 the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) began the Urban Development Action Grant (UDAG) program to assist commercial, industrial, and housing projects in communities that would not otherwise be built without federal assistance, and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell made an application for UDAG funds in the amount of \$3 million dollars to assist the Transportation Manufacturing Corporation at the Roswell International Air Center (R.I.A.C.), and

WHEREAS, on February 28, 1980, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 1767 declaring the City Council's Intent to Retain Urban Development Grant Money in the Airport Fund for project expansion by Transportation Manufacturing Corporation at R.I.A.C. and to facilitate additional industrial development at the R.I.A.C., and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell UDAG program facilitated development and economic activity for various companies at R.I.A.C., and

WHEREAS, the UDAG program ended in 1988 at the federal level and in August 2017 HUD posted online a notification informing grantees/recipients that their UDAG awards from FY 1988 and earlier were closed, and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to expand the use of the funds at R.I.A.C.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Roswell that:


1. Resolution No. 1767 is hereby repealed.
