

RESOLUTION 19-50

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that:

A. A Municipal Officer's Election for the election of municipal officers shall be held on March 3, 2020. Polls will open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m.

B. At the Municipal Officer's Election, persons shall be elected to fill the following elective offices:

- One Municipal Judge for one (1) four (4) year term.
- One Councilor from Ward 1 for one (1) four (4) year term.
- One Councilor from Ward 2 for one (1) four (4) year term.
- One Councilor from Ward 3 for one (1) four (4) year term.
- One Councilor from Ward 4 for one (1) four (4) year term.
- One Councilor from Ward 5 for one (1) four (4) year term.

C. The following locations are designated as polling places or Voter Convenience Centers (all voters in the City of Roswell may vote at these locations, regardless of where they live) for the conduct of the Municipal Officer's Election.

D. **ABSENTEE VOTING.** Absentee voting begins Tuesday, February 4, 2020. Applications for absentee ballots may be obtained only from the office of the Municipal Clerk. The last day to mail absentee ballots is Friday, February 28, 2020. The Municipal Clerk will accept completed absentee ballots delivered by mail, or in person by the voter casting the absentee ballot, by a member of the voter's immediate family, or by the caregiver to the voter until 7:00 p.m. on March 3, 2020.

E. **EARLY VOTING.** Early voting on paper ballots counted by a Dominion vote tabulator will be conducted in the office of the Municipal Clerk (City Hall - 425 N. Richardson Ave., Roswell, NM) during the regular hours and days of business, beginning on Tuesday, February 4, 2020 and on Saturday, February 29, 2020 from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

F. All Declarations of Candidacy shall be filed with the Municipal Clerk (City Hall - 425 N. Richardson Ave., Roswell, NM) on Tuesday, January 7, 2020, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.

G. On Election Day the casting of votes by qualified municipal electors shall be recorded on paper ballots to be counted by a Dominion electronic vote tabulator.

H. The Municipal Clerk having determined that consolidation is in the best interest of the precincts and will not compromise the orderly and efficient conduct of the election, all precincts shall be consolidated into one precinct which will have the boundaries of the City of Roswell with five (5) centrally located polling locations which will make voting more convenient and accessible to voters of the consolidated precinct and will not result in delays for voters in the voting process.
