

RESOLUTION NO. 1620

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell, Chaves County, New Mexico, pursuant to the provisions of the Community Development Act of 1974 has heretofore held public hearings on 17 and 25 February, 1975 to encourage input from all segments of the community for the purpose of pin-pointing Pre-Applications by the municipality for Federal Grant of Funds in aid of needful community development projects in the respective amounts as follows:

- A. Chaves County Boy's Home -
Acquisition of Home. \$ 30,000.
- B. Melendez Park - Expansion of
Recreation Facilities \$ 30,000.
- C. Chaves County Memorial Youth
Center - Expansion and Improvement . . . \$100,000.
- D. Planning Department - Planning and
Management \$ 25,000.
- E. Poe Corn Annex - Expansion and Improve-
ment of Recreation Facilities. \$ 40,000.
- F. East Side Drainage - Initiate Master
Drainage Plan. \$256,000.
- G. Clearance Project - Removal of Deterior-
ated and Dilapidated Structures on
East Side \$ 40,000.
- H. Loan and Grants - Substandard Housing. . . . \$ 60,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

1. That the above and foregoing Pre-Applications Projects be, and the same hereby are accepted and approved as bona-fide and viable needs, contributing to an integrated development of the community, subject to and conditioned upon approval, detailed plans and specifications of the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development upon said City's formal application made.

2. That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they hereby are authorized and directed to submit formal application on behalf of the City of Roswell as to any or all of the Pre-Application projects hereinabove set forth in the respective amounts for each project as hereafter shall be approved by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and, to and perform any and all such other acts, matters and manner of things as shall be and become necessary and proper to effectuate the purposes herein.
