

RESOLUTION NO. 1663

WHEREAS, at the special general obligation bond election duly called and held within the City of Roswell (herein sometimes designated as the "City"), on Tuesday, the 7th day of September, 1976, a majority of the total votes cast therein *approved* (~~or~~) ~~*disapproved*~~ the question of issuing general obligation library bonds in an amount of not exceeding \$1,250,000, as authorized to be submitted by the 1976 Bond Election Resolution duly adopted on July 13, 1976 (hereinafter referred to as the "resolution"), by the City Council of the City (herein sometimes designated as the "governing body"), which question is herein incorporated by reference in full; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk has so certified to the governing body of the City.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. The above certificate of the Clerk be accepted and the same is hereby spread upon the minutes of the City Council.

Section 2. It is hereby declared and determined that at the election of September 7, 1976, a majority of the registered voters *approved* (~~or~~) ~~*disapproved*~~ the issuance of the City's general obligation library bonds in the amount of not exceeding \$1,250,000.

Section 3. All action heretofore taken by the City Council and officers of the City, not inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution, directed toward the calling and conducting of said bond election be and the same hereby is, ratified, approved and confirmed.
