RESOLUTION NO. 1665

WHEREAS, in order to maintain normal supply capacity of the municipal water system, critical to the welfare of the community during prolonged hot weather seasons, and to provide a reserve for fire-fighting, restructuring of Well No. 3 of the Roswell Industrial Air Center water supply system is mandatory in order to sustain normal distribution through the conduit network, and


WHEREAS, capital expenditure to defray the costs of such well restructuring, including shaft and other parts and materials and including labor is estimated to be \$3,700.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

To insure the uninterrupted supply of water within the municipal distribution system, the City Manager is hereby empowered and directed to make emergency purchase by order without bids at the documented best available price the necessary parts, materials and labor for such well restructuring, all in accordance with 6-5-27 NMS 1953 as amended in such case made and provided.


Any such emergency purchases will be reported by the City Manager to the State Department of Finance and Administration and to the State Auditor within thirty (30) days, stating a full description of the emergency necessitating the purchase, the items and respective purchase prices, together with the name and address of the supplier, accompanied by a certified true copy of this Resolution, evidencing certification of the municipal governing body of the necessity for emergency purchase.

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
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
