RESOLUTION NO. 1677

WHEREAS, the economy of New Mexico municipalities requires that a regular, substantial, and reliable source of income be established to provide for the needs of municipal residents; and,

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 99 and Senate Bill 103, which authorize various increases in the Gross Receipts Tax, would provide such a reliable and consistent source of monies to New Mexico municipalities; and,

WHEREAS, it is imperative that the aforesaid Senate Bills 99 and 103 be enacted into law by the Thirty-third session of the New Mexico Legislature to provide a solution to the more urgent fiscal problems of this City and of other communities in the State; and,

WHEREAS, said Senate Bills 99 and 103 have been assigned to the Senate Finance Committee for evaluation and recommendation.



The Senate Finance Committee chaired by Senator Aubrey Dunn, be, and hereby is, informed that the passage and enactment into law of Senate Bills 99 and 103 is a matter of urgent concern to this City and that the Governing Body of the City of Roswell enthusiastically and thoroughly supports the provisions of said Bills, and that the Senate Finance Committee is strongly urged to recommend the passage of said Bills.
