

RESOLUTION NO. 1732

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A JOINT POWER AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL WITH THE ROSWELL INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR DEVELOPMENT OF A TENNIS COMPLEX.

WHEREAS, the Roswell Independent School District has ownership and possession of certain lands within Chaves County, New Mexico, suitable for use as neighborhood parks; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell within its recreational program desires to create a recreational area primarily devoted to recreational activities for the benefit of the citizens of the City of Roswell; and,

WHEREAS, the Roswell Independent School District and the City of Roswell could utilize the same recreational area for the benefit of the District's students and the citizens of the City of Roswell by consolidating the efforts of each party; and,

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Roswell and the School Board of the Roswell Independent School District have written an agreement wherein each governing body contributes substantially in proportion to their anticipated use of the Tennis Complex on school land; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell is in agreement that it should join with the Roswell Independent School District as authorized by the Joint Powers Agreement Act, in the development of this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL that the Mayor should be and hereby is authorized to execute such agreement on behalf of the City of Roswell.
