

RESOLUTION NO. 1801

A RESOLUTION PROTESTING THE RATE INCREASE
REQUESTED BY MOUNTAIN STATES TELEPHONE AND
TELEGRAPH COMPANY.

WHEREAS, Mountain States Telephone and Telegraph Company has requested authorization from the New Mexico Public Service Commission to increase its rates for telephone service in New Mexico, and

WHEREAS, the requested rate increase would approximately double the monthly base service rate, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Roswell, New Mexico, considers the requested rate increase would be injurious to the citizens of the City and further that the proposed increase is unjustified,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that the Council does protest the rate increase requested by Mountain States Telephone and Telegraph Company as being unjustified and as being injurious to the citizens of Roswell. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is hereby directed to send a duly authenticated copy of this Resolution to the State Public Service Commission for the Commission's consideration.
