

RESOLUTION NO. 1845

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL ADOPTING THE FACILITIES PLAN AMENDMENT FOR WASTEWATER TREATMENT AND COLLECTION SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS AS PREPARED BY WILSON AND COMPANY ENGINEERS AND ARCHITECTS DATED MARCH, 1982.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Roswell has contracted with Wilson and Company Engineers and Architects to prepare a Facilities Plan Amendment for Wastewater Treatment and Collection System Improvements, and


WHEREAS, this Facilities Plan Amendment has been completed under EPA Project No. C-351052-01-1, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Roswell has held three (3) advertised legal Public Hearings concerning the development and content of the Facilities Plan Amendment,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that the City Council hereby adopts the Facilities Plan Amendment for Wastewater Treatment and Collection System Improvements dated March, 1982. We further select the Water Reclamation Algae Production (WRAP) system with algae sludge dewatering on sand drying beds and disposal in the municipal landfill as our first choice of treatment alternatives. We further adopt the Two Stage Trickling Filter system with sludge dewatering on sand drying beds and give away to agricultural users as our second choice of treatment facilities in case the WRAP system is not acceptable to the Environmental Protection Agency.
