

RESOLUTION NO. 1877

A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND AUTHORIZING IMMEDIATE ACTION AND PURCHASE UNDER AUTHORITY OF SECTION 13-1-15 NMSA (1978).

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell has a sewer lift station at the intersection of Mescalero and Orchard Streets, and,

WHEREAS, the pump at the station has deteriorated faster than anticipated, and,

WHEREAS, immediate replacement is necessary to insure the health and safety of the public, and,


WHEREAS, the Public Purchases Act, Section 13-1-15 authorizes emergency purchases by order without bids in an unforeseen situation requiring immediate action to preserve property within the jurisdiction of the City, and,

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has negotiated for and caused to be completed the necessary repairs.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND DECLARED by the governing body, the City Council, of Roswell, New Mexico, that an emergency situation necessitating immediate action does exist in the instance of the failure of the sewer lift station at Mescalero and Orchard Streets. The City Purchasing Agent is authorized to proceed with payment for purchase of a replacement pump without bids in conformity with this Resolution and the Public Purchases Act.
