

RESOLUTION NO. 1894

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL
ESTABLISHING AN APPLICATION AND APPROVAL
POLICY FOR SIDEWALK SALES IN THE CITY.

WHEREAS, merchants from time to time desire to temporarily use a portion of the public sidewalk adjacent to their businesses for display and sale of merchandise, and


WHEREAS, individual consideration of such requests by the City Council often imposes a hardship on the merchants in that their requests can be approved at only meeting each month, and

WHEREAS, sidewalk sales have been regularly approved by the City Council, subject to the restrictions that adequate insurance coverage be in force, that only a portion of the sidewalk may be used, that pedestrian traffic may not be impeded, and that the activity occur only during the dates and times approved by the City Council,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that:

1. Subject to the foregoing conditions and the limits herein sidewalk sales are hereby approved by the City Council and the Community Development Director is authorized to issue approvals of sidewalk sales.
2. Sidewalk sales approved by the Community Development Director shall have a duration of no more than 3 days in any calendar week and must be approved at least one week in advance of the sale.
3. The City Council reserves the right to award or rescind the conditions of this resolution.
