

RESOLUTION NO. 1944

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF
ROSWELL PROHIBITING PARKING
ALONG WEST SECOND STREET BE-
TWEEN VIRGINIA AND SUNSET
AVENUES IN ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the New Mexico State Highway Department has determined that the provision of additional traffic lanes on West Second Street would provide a needed increase in roadway volume capacity, and


WHEREAS, the additional lanes will require removal of existing parking spaces along West Second Street between Main Street and Sunset Avenue effective on and after October 1, 1984, and

WHEREAS, parking is already prohibited on West Second Street from Virginia Avenue to Main Street,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO that effective on and after October 1, 1984 parking along Second Street from Virginia Avenue to Sunset Avenue shall be prohibited and further that the City shall place appropriate signs and markings along the street to indicate that parking is prohibited.
