

RESOLUTION NO. 1960

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SENATE BILL NO. 97 WHICH PROPOSES FUNDING FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT BOTTOMLESS LAKES STATE PARK.

WHEREAS, Bottomless Lakes State Park, which encompasses 1300 acres of land and 60 acres of water, was honored by being named the first State Park in September, 1933, and

WHEREAS, said State Park was listed as Priority #3 by the State Natural Resources Department in its 1985 Capital Improvements Request, and

WHEREAS, in 17 years, only very minimal capital improvements have been made at the park so that the facilities have deteriorated to the point that it is an eyesore and potentially hazardous to the health, welfare and safety of visitors, and


WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 97 proposes funding for requisite improvements, and

WHEREAS, with said improvements, said State Park can be rendered a viable recreational site for local residents and tourists alike;
