RESOLUTION NO. 1984

WHEREAS, the City Council (the "Council") of the City of Roswell, in the County of Chaves and State of New Mexico (the "City"), has heretofore, in accordance with the provisions of law relating thereto, given the requisite legal notice that specific objections to the amount of assessments for improvements in Roswell, New Mexico, Pavement District No. 1985-1 should be filed with the City Clerk of the City and that the Council would hear and consider any of said objections on Tuesday, November 12, 1985, at 7:30 p.m., at the City Hall in the City; and

WHEREAS, The Council met at that place and time to hear and consider all the objections made or filed; and

WHEREAS, all objections, both written and oral, were heard and considered by the Council and after extensive review and deliberation hereby are found to be without merit and overruled; provided, however, that the Council has, nevertheless, concluded that it is necessary and equitable that the assessment roll be corrected and revised as shown on Attachment "A" to this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. The Council of the City hereby validates and confirms the assessment roll and the assessments therein for Roswell, New Mexico Pavement District No. 1985-1 as prepared by the Council of the City, together with Albert Cates, the City Engineer, and filed in the office of the City Clerk on October 18, 1985, and as hereinabove revised, corrected and made de novo.

Section 2. All action heretofore taken not inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution by the City and the officers of the City directed toward performing all prerequisites to levying special assessments and confirming the assessment roll and the assessments therein hereby is ratified, approved and confirmed.

Section 3. All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of the section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.

Section 5. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure on the ground of urgent public need and, therefore, immediately upon its final passage, shall be recorded in the book of resolutions of the City kept for that purpose, authenticated by the signature of the Mayor of the City, attested by the City Clerk, and shall be in force and effect after passage and approval.
