

RESOLUTION NO. 1988

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE ROSWELL CITY COUNCIL'S DESIRE TO HAVE THE U. S. 285 WEST BYPASS DESIGNED AND CONSTRUCTED WITH LIMITED ACCESS.

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell has requested that a U. S. 285 West Bypass be placed on the New Mexico State Highway Department's Five Year Plan, and


WHEREAS, the New Mexico State Highway Department has allocated funds and selected an Engineer for the design of a U. S. 285 West Bypass, and

WHEREAS, the Roswell City Council desires to have the U. S. 285 West Bypass designed and constructed with limited access.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body, the City Council of the City of Roswell, New Mexico, that:


1. The City Council supports a limited access philosophy for the U. S. 285 West Bypass.
2. The City Council urges the New Mexico State Highway Department to have the project designed and constructed with limited access with provisions for access to only (a) Pine Lodge Road, (b) No. Sycamore, (c) Berrendo Road, (d) Country Club Road, (e) W. 2nd, (f) McGaffey Street, (g) Brasher Road, (h) So. Sunset Ave., and (i) So. Main Street.
