

RESOLUTION NO. 2019

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF
ROSWELL ADOPTING THE DOWNTOWN
ROSWELL HISTORIC DISTRICT
GUIDELINES DATED SEPTEMBER
9, 1986.


WHEREAS, the City Planning and Zoning Commission has reviewed and recommended certain nonbinding guidelines relating to structures in the Downtown Roswell Historic District, and

WHEREAS, it appears the guidelines, designated "Downtown Roswell Historic District Guidelines, September 9, 1986," reflect a consensus by the property owners in the district and would facilitate notification of future owners of desired performance standards for the district, and

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the probable benefit of voluntary adherence to such uniform development standards,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that the "Downtown Roswell Historic District Guidelines, September 9, 1986," are hereby approved and adopted as voluntary standards for the Downtown Roswell Historic District and all property owners therein are hereby encouraged to cooperate in implementing said guidelines.
