A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL EXPRESSING
THE CITY COUNCIL'S SUPPORT FOR ENACTMENT OF
RIGHT TO WORK LEGISLATION IN NEW MEXICO.

WHEREAS, individual liberty and freedom has long
been the support of this country, this state, and this
community, and

WHEREAS, conditions that impinge upon a citizen's
free exercise of the right to contract for employment should
be carefully considered by government in order that no burden
should be imposed that does not give rise to a greater good,
and


WHEREAS, it appears economic growth is most enhanced

the city of Roswell;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING
