

RESOLUTION NO. 2304

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO APPROVING APPLICATION FOR NEW MEXICO STATE HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT FUNDS FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF WEST HOBBS STREET FROM UNION AVENUE TO SUNSET AVENUE

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to reconstruct West Hobbs Street from Union Avenue to Sunset Avenue, and

WHEREAS, this section of West Hobbs Street is eligible for New Mexico State Highway and Transportation Department (NMSHTD) Cooperative Agreement (CO-OP) funds, and

WHEREAS, the preliminary cost estimate for the West Hobbs Street Project is \$200,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to utilize NMSHTD CO-OP funds for the construction of the West Hobbs Street Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND DECLARED by the Governing Body, the City Council of the City of Roswell, New Mexico that:

1. The City of Roswell fully supports and endorses the proposed project to reconstruct West Hobbs Street from Union Avenue to Sunset Avenue.
2. The City Engineer of the City of Roswell is authorized to prepare all the necessary plans and documents required to submit an application for NMSHTD CO-OP funding for the West Hobbs Street Project for the 1996-97 fiscal year.
3. The funds, equipment, labor and materials required to complete the project will be available when the Cooperative Agreement becomes effective.
