

RESOLUTION 2328

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO FILE A NEW MEXICO TRAILS GRANT APPLICATION ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell recognizes the importance of recreation trails in its parks and recreation system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell is intent on expanding its present trail system identified as the Spring River Parkway and provide access to the new regional park located at the Old Municipal Airport; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell also deems it necessary to install and construct a safe crossing of the current trail at Union Avenue into Cahoon Park; and


WHEREAS, the New Mexico Recreational Trails Funding Program provides a 50 percent Federal match for each successful grant proposal; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell Parks and Recreation Commission and Committee recommend the submission of an application for funds for 1996 and 1997.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Roswell and the Governing Body, hereby authorize the staff to prepare and the Mayor to submit an application on its' behalf, consistent with the proposal approved by the Parks and Recreation Commission and Committee at a meeting conducted on August 26, 1996.
