

RESOLUTION NO. 2337

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, SUPPORTING EFFORTS TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO RELOCATE THE MAIN ENTRANCE OF THE ROSWELL MUSEUM AND ART CENTER AND CONSTRUCTION OF A PEDESTRIAN WALKWAY ACROSS THE SPRING RIVER CHANNEL ACCESSING THE PARKING AREAS AND THE ROSWELL CONVENTION AND CIVIC CENTER.**

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Roswell, State of New Mexico, recognizes the need for improvements, modifications, and additions to the Roswell Museum and Art Center, and

WHEREAS, said improvements would greatly enhance access to and use of the Roswell Museum and Art Center, particularly the planned Patricia Lubben Bassett Art and Education Center, an 8,000 square foot, \$750,000.00 privately-funded addition, scheduled for construction in 1997, and

WHEREAS, in times of scarce resources, it is necessary to seek funding from various sources, municipal, state, and private, to complete this project;


