**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO APPROVING AND SUPPORTING THE CITY'S EFFORTS OF WATER CONSERVATION BY THE USE OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL WATER CONSERVATION PROGRAM GUIDE.**

**WHEREAS:** Water in New Mexico is a publicly owned resource, and may be diverted only for the purpose and beneficial use; and

**WHEREAS:** The City Council is the trustee of the City's water supply in accordance with the laws and regulations of the State of New Mexico; and

**WHEREAS:** Water is a valuable resource that should be wisely used to benefit human health, safety, productivity and environment; and

**WHEREAS:** Efficient use of water will increase long-term water-supply and reduce waste water treatment costs in the community; and

**WHEREAS:** The City of Roswell City Council desires to ensure there is a sufficient amount of potable water available for the public; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY, THE CITY COUNCIL, OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, that:**


- 1) The City of Roswell fully supports and endorses the Water Conservation Program Guide revision dated February 4, 1997.
