

**RESOLUTION 2355**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO, ADOPTING - PECOS TRAILS TRANSIT & HANDIVAN'S DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Roswell applies annually for Federal assistance for transportation programs operated by Pecos Trails Transit & Handivan of the City of Roswell; and


**WHEREAS**, under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and 49 CFR Part 23 and the terms of the Federal Transit Administration's grant agreement with the City, grant recipients obtain financial assistance from the Department of Transportation for compliance with Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) programs in federally supported contracting activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Roswell, New Mexico - Pecos Trails Transit & Handivan has adopted a program for DBE which is in accordance with the New Mexico State Highway and Transportation Department's policies. Pecos Trails Transit & Handivan may make use of the NMSHTD's list and may make use of other certified DBE lists approved in the state such as those established in Albuquerque, Santa Fe, and Las Cruces, New Mexico; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Roswell, New Mexico - Pecos Trails Transit & Handivan is required to establish goals for participation of DBE under the terms of the Federal Acts and Regulations as amended.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Roswell and the Governing Body that it hereby adopts by reference the New Mexico State Highway and Transportation Department Disadvantaged Business Assistance Programs, as referenced in SHTD Rule 91-1 dated February 21, 1992, as the same may, from time to time, be amended.
