**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING
A RESIDENTIAL ANTI-DISPLACEMENT AND
RELOCATION ASSISTANCE PLAN & CERTIFICATION AND
A LOCAL RELOCATION POLICY**

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to participate in the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) funded by the State of New Mexico and the Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to participate in various Housing Grant opportunities and programs funded by the New Mexico Mortgage Finance Authority (MFA) and the Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell wishes to comply will all of the program's requirements, guidelines and objectives, and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell encourages all qualified citizens to participate to the fullest in programs designed to offer improvements to neighborhoods and residential housing, and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Roswell will receive "quality of life" benefits from proposed capital projects funded by grant awards

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the governing body, the City Council of Roswell, New Mexico: That the governing body hereby adopts the following plan and policy

1. A Residential Anti-Displacement and Relocation Assistance Plan and Certification and
2. A Local Relocation Policy
