A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO
NOTIFYING THE NEW MEXICO STATE HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT
THAT THE CITY OF ROSWELL HAS THE REQUIRED MATCH FOR THE COOPERATIVE
AGREEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE REALIGNMENT AND RECONSTRUCTION OF SOUTH
VIRGINIA AVENUE FROM REED STREET TO SUMMIT STREET

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to realign and reconstruct South Virginia Avenue
from Reed Street to Summit Street, and

WHEREAS, this roadway is eligible for New Mexico State Highway and Transportation
Department (NMSHTD) Cooperative Agreement (CO-OP) funds, and


WHEREAS, the preliminary cost estimate for the South Virginia Project is \$168,976.20, and

WHEREAS, the City of Roswell desires to utilize NMSHTD CO-OP funds for the
realignment and reconstruction of South Virginia Avenue.

City Council of the City of Roswell, New Mexico that:


1. The City of Roswell fully supports and endorses the proposed project to realign and
