

RESOLUTION 2460

WHEREAS, at the special bond election duly called and held within the City of Roswell (herein the "City"), on Tuesday, May 18, 1999, 2 separate general obligation bond questions were submitted to the qualified voters of the City, which questions were authorized to be submitted by Resolution No. 2448, duly adopted on March 11, 1999, by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk and Magistrate Judge Eugene M. De Los Santos (who together constitute a Municipal Canvassing Board) have certified the results of the election on each question in the Certificate of Canvass presented to the Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO THAT:

Section 1. The above Certificate of Canvass is accepted and the same is hereby spread upon the minutes of the governing body.

Section 2. It is hereby declared and determined that the election of May 18, 1999, resulted as follows:

(1) The proposition to issue the City's general obligation public library bonds in the amount of \$3,600,000.00 carried by a majority of the total votes cast; and

(2) The proposition to issue the City's general obligation fire stations bonds in the amount of not exceeding \$3,000,000.00 carried by a majority of the total votes cast.

Section 3. All action heretofore taken by the governing body and officers of the City, not inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution, directed toward the calling and conducting of said election be, and the same is hereby ratified, approved and confirmed.
