

## Recreation Basketball FAQ

**Q: When is basketball registration open?**

**A: Ages 5 - 8 is September 1-30 and ages 9 - 12 is November 1-30**

**Q: When does the season start for ages 5-8?**

**A: Teams will be set October 4, 2021. Practice will begin October 16, 2021 with games beginning November 1, 2021.**

**Q: How much does basketball registration cost?**

**A: Registration is \$42 including tax**

**Q: What ages can play basketball?**

**A: Ages 5 through 12 can play basketball**

**Q: Do I need to buy a uniform? Can a team buy their own uniform or does the team have to wear the uniform provided?**

**A: A uniform is part of the registration cost. A team is provided a uniform and are required to wear that uniform.**

**Q: Is a team required to practice at the Recreation Center or can we practice somewhere else?**

**A: The only approved practice location is the Recreation Center.**

**Q: How are the teams created?**

**A: Teams in the 5-6 boys/girls and 7-8 boys, 7-8 girls divisions will be placed with kids from their school; however, if necessary, a player may be placed on a team from a neighboring school area.**

**Teams in the 9-10 boys, 9-10 girls, 11-12 boys and 11-12 girls will be placed by a draft.**

**Q: What size of basketball will the team use?**

**A: Ages 5-6 will use a 27.5" size basketball. Ages 7-10 will use a 28.5" size basketball. Ages 11-12 girls will use a 28.5" size basketball. Ages 11-12 boys will use a full size or 29.5" basketball.**

**Q: What height will the goal be set at?**

**A: Ages 5-6 will play at a 8' goal. Ages 7-8 will play at an 8'6" goal. Ages 9-10 will play at a 9' goal. Ages 11-12 will play at a 10' goal.**

**Q: Who will officiate the games?**

**A: One coach from each team will officiate the 5-6 boys/girls games. There will be officials for the 7-8, 9-10, 11-12 boys and girls divisions.**

**Q: What is the birthday cut-off date used to decide the age divisions for basketball?**

**A: The age of the child as of December 31, 2021 will be used to decide which age division a child will be placed in.**
